Sub: Clearance of NPS subscription booked under Code Head 00/016/04 and 00/016/05 at the end of each financial year by uploading of NPS Subscription in subscribers' PRAN.

As per instructions on the subject, NPS subscription booked under code head 00/016/04 (Rt)- Government Servant's Contribution under tier-I and 016/05 (Rt) - Government Contribution under tier-I must be cleared before the close of each financial year by uploading of NPS subscription in subscribers' PRANs & remitting the amount to the Trustee Bank. No balance should be pending for uploading at the end of financial year strictly.

In case any balance booked under the code heads 00/016/04 & 00/016/05 is found outstanding on 31st March 2018, disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against the Officer-In-Charge.

At the close of previous financial year, many cases had come to notice where NPS subscription booked by certain PAOs were observed outstanding under the NPS code heads due to non uploading of NPS subscription in subscribers' PRANs which have been viewed seriously by the competent authorities.

Therefore, it is enjoined upon that the booking made by your section/office under code head 00/016/05 & 00/016/04 may please be reviewed immediately and misclassification, if any may be rectified before closing of current financial year.

A certificate to the effect that no NPS data as compiled under 00/016/04 & 00/016/05 in 2017-18 is pending for uploading and the balance under the heads is NIL, must be submitted by 26-03-2018 positively under signature of the officer in charge.

Non compliance thereof may be reflected in APAR
