Subject : Repair of vehicles and mobile plant machinery on payment in EME workshops.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the adoption of the following methods by EME workshops for calculating the light and field repair charges in respect of vehicles and mobile plant machinery in respect of non Army organizations:-

Charges from 25 April, 2015 to 31 December 2015 (as per 6th Pay Commission).

(a) Cost of Labour. The cost of labour unit will be calculated at Rs. 572.00 per hour per man for combatants and Rs. 203.00 per hour per man for civilians.

- (i) No. of hours auth to work in a year for combatant - 920 hours
- (ii) No. of hours auth to work in a year for civilian - 1747 hours

(b) Cost of Spares. The cost of spares will be calculated as per the prevailing PV rates. Spares will include repair to engines and expendable stores normally issued by EME Workshops but not replacement of the following items:-

- (i) Tyres and Tubes.
- (ii) Batteries.
- (iii) Tarpaulines.
- (iv) Seats and Seat Covers.

(c) Overhead Charges. Overhead charges at Rs. 583.00 per hour for combatant and Rs. 207.00 per hour for civilian (@ 102% of the cost of labour) will be levied in the case of non service organizations.

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(d) **Departmental Charges.** Departmental charges of 5% on the cost of stores will be added, where applicable, in accordance with the instructions contained in Para 268 of Equipment Regulations for the Army, Revised Edition 1981.

Charges from 01 January, 2016 to 24 April, 2018 (as per 7th Pay Commission).

(e) **Cost of Labour.** The cost of labour unit will be calculated at **Rs. 696.00** per hour per man for combatants and **Rs. 253.00** per hour per man for civilians.

- (i) No. of hours auth to work in a year for combatant - 920 hours
 (ii) No. of hours auth to work in a year for civilian - 1747 hours

(f) **Cost of Spares.** The cost of spares will be calculated as per the prevailing PV rates. Spares will include repair to engines and expendable stores normally issued by EME Workshops but not replacement of the following items:-

- (i) Tyres and Tubes.
 (ii) Batteries.
 (iii) Tarpaulines.
 (iv) Seats and Seat Covers.

(g) **Overhead Charges.** Overhead charges at **Rs. 710.00** per hour for combatant and **Rs. 258.00** per hour for civilian (@ 102% of the cost of labour) will be levied in the case of non service organizations.

(d) **Departmental Charges.** Departmental charges of 5% on the cost of stores will be added, where applicable, in accordance with the instructions contained in Para 268 of Equipment Regulations for the Army, Revised Edition 1981.

2. The above scale of charges do not cover repair of damages or defects arising from misuse or neglect. The cost of repair in all such cases will be recovered in addition to the flat rate charges on the basis of actual cost of labour and stores as mentioned in Para 4 of the next page.


3. The repair charges mentioned above will be operative for a period of three years from **25 April, 2015 to 24 April, 2018.**

4. Charges for base repairs will be levied on the basis of actual cost of labour and stores, including overhead/departmental charges, where applicable, in accordance with instructions contained in Para 268 of Equipment Regulation for the Army, Revised Edition 1981.
